



Procedure in the event of a Corona case:

1. Institute goes into emergency operation.
2. The corona officer initiates the disinfection of the infected person's workplace and equipment.
3. The corona officer notifies the company doctor and contacts the public health department.
4. The corona officer creates a list of the infected person's Category One and Two contact persons.
5. Category one contacts go into quarantine – further procedure in coordination with the public health department.
6. Category two contacts remain in the home office until a negative corona test (by the family doctor).
7. All other persons return to the workplace after 24 to 48 hours in consultation with the company doctor.
8. Red rules apply for 2 weeks

Where can I get tested for coronavirus infection?

First of all, please contact your physician by phone. Do not go to the practice without prior appointment. In urgent cases call 116 117.

Definition of contact person category One:

- People who have had face-to-face contact with an infected person for at least 15 minutes within the last 2 weeks – for example, during a conversation.
- People who have had direct contact with secretions or body fluids of a confirmed COVID-19 case within the last 2 weeks – e.g. during kissing, contact with vomit, mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, coughing or sneezing.

Definition of contact person category Two:

- People who have had contact with infected persons within the last 2 weeks, but who do not belong to category one, belong to category two. This means, for example, staying in the same room, but there was no face-to-face contact for at least 15 minutes.
- People who have had at least 15 minutes of face-to-face contact with a Category One contact person within the last 2 weeks – for example, during a conversation.
- People who have had direct contact with the secretions or body fluids of a Category One contact person within the last 2 weeks – for example, kissing, vomiting, mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, coughing or sneezing.
